Sub: BIE, A.P. – Academic – Instructional Periods and Timing Schedule for all Junior Colleges in the State for the Academic Year 2026–27 – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

All the Principals of Junior Colleges in the State are hereby informed that the working hours for Junior Colleges for the Academic Year 2026–27 onwards, shall consist of 8 (eight) periods per day. Each of the first seven periods shall be of 50 minutes duration and the eighth period shall be of 60 minutes duration. Students shall be engaged during all the eight periods, irrespective of the course of study.

2) Further, it is informed that they should follow the below instructions scrupulously:

- No classes or tests shall be conducted on Sundays and public holidays.

- All institutions shall strictly adhere to the Annual Academic Calendar for the Academic Year 2026-27 issued by BIE, A.P., without any deviation.
- For Science groups, 9 instructional Periods per week (3 Periods for Mathematics/ Biology, 3 Periods for Physics and 3 Periods for Chemistry) must be allotted for competitive coaching (CC) i.e., EAPCET, JEE, NEET, etc.
- For every week, 3 Periods for science, 2 Periods for Humanities must be allotted to Co-curricular activities, sports, library, etc., as per the prescribed workload provided hereunder.
